LB 65, 112, 102

SENATOR KEYES: Oh, that is all right then. We have accepted the committee amendments and the amputees and all that. Okay, thanks.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to move the advancement of the bill?

SENATOR KEYES: I move for the advancement of the bill then.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance LB 65 to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, say aye, sorry. Opposed no. The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Now we move to LB 112. Do we have E & R amendments?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do have E & R amendments to LB 112.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 112.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, the motion is that the E & R amendments to LB 112 be adopted. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. The motion is carried.

SENATOR WESELY: I move to advance LB 112 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance the bill to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill is LB 102.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 102 had been on Final Reading. Senator DeCamp had made a motion on March 15th to return the bill to Select File for specific amendment. The bill was returned for that specific amendment. The amendment is now pending. That amendment is on page 926 of the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Labeledz, do you want to handle the amendments?

SENATOR LABEDZ: Yes. On March 5th, Senator DeCamp introduced an amendment which was passed and then later he came up with a very short amendment, was correcting some of the language that was in error and left off of his original amendment, and I approve of the amendment and ask for its adoption.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is to adopt the amendment to LB 102.
