SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: Has everybody recorded their presence? Senator Nichol, are you ready to take up 237? Have you all recorded your presence? Okay. Clerk, record.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The first bill this afternoon is on the first page, eleventh from the bottom, LB 237. The Clerk will read 237.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 237.) The bill was first read on January 11. It was referred to the Judiciary Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are amendments by Senator Nichol's Judiciary Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, first of all the committee amendments to this bill are to clarify language used to effectively implement the act. The amendments do two things. First, with reference to active practice it was felt the word "active" could not be easily defined, therefore, it has been stricken throughout the act. Also it was felt that some clarification must be added to residents' requirement. Therefore that residents' requirement will be that "on the effective date of appointment" of the judge. I move for the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the committee amendments to LB 237. We are voting on the committee amendments to LB 237. The amendments are adopted. Now do you have another amendment on the desk, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried and the committee amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Haberman now moves to amend. In line 8, on page 6, line 8, section 6, strike "five" and insert "three" and on page 6, line 10, strike "thirty" and insert "twenty five".
