CLERK: Senator Marsh voting aye.

SENATOR MARSH: Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Madam President.

SENATOR MARSH: LB 536 is advanced. We are now ready and will hear 267.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 267.) The bill was first read on January 15. It was referred to the Government Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments by Senator Keyes' Government Committee.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Keyes, I call on you for the committee amendments to 267. Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: What bill are we on? I'm on a different one down here.

SENATOR MARSH: LB 267, introduced by Senator Newell.

SENATOR KEYES: Senator Newell, do you know what this is about, the amendments on it?

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: If I can move the committee amendments, basically the committee amendments add any water and rail transportation system should also be looked at in terms of the consolidation, possible consolidation or study of a consolidation and development of a D.O.T., Department of Transportation.
