SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me, Senator Keyes, we are on LB 414.

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, and all of these bills have been incorporated into LB 414 and I move for the adoption of the committee amendments which are these various bills that we have put in one bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You have heard the motion to adopt the committee amendments to LB 414. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no.
