SENATOR LEWIS: That Call was raised.

Welcome to the Legislature. Now with that, Senator Kahle, you have got to come back downstairs. Senator Fitzgerald.

CLERK: Senator Fitzgerald voting aye.

CLERK: Senator George voting aye. Senator Koch voting no.
