SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I now move LB 65 to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is returned. The Clerk has some things to read into the record.

Mr. President, your Committee on Banking, Commerce and Insurance whose Chairman is Senator DeCamp to whom we referred LB 216 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File, 332 advanced to General File, and 354 to General File. Signed Senator DeCamp.
