SENATOR VENDITTE: Okay, John, that's fine, thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is on the DeCamp amendments to LB 23. All those in favor of those amendments vote aye, opposed no. Senator Lewis do you want to be recognized before the vote?

SENATOR LEWIS: After the vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Clerk record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The DeCamp amendments have been adopted.

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. President, I just wanted to ask Senator DeCamp a question if he'd accept a friendly amendment, I think Senator Maresh wants to put it on, so that we don't have to come back again and deal with this subject. Would it be all right to include prestige plates for mopeds... put that amendment on and just let it ride?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Sure, I'm sure Senator Merz would go for that. Go on to the next amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you got it there?
