SENATOR MURPHY: No, I would...I have no desire to impair the advancement of the bill, Senator. I'll support advancement of the bill, and hopefully those people who are involved can take a hard look at it and see if maybe they could make recommendations. I'm not trying in any way to change the effect of the bill. I simply don't want to leave too many loose ends.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion first of all is the adoption of the Committee amendments to LB 538. All those in favor of the motion vote aye. Opposed no. We're voting on the Committee amendments to LB 538, and then if they're adopted we'll move to advance the bill. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried, and the amendments are adopted. Now Senator Schmit, do you want to move the advancement of the bill?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, Senator Marvel, and again in response to Senator Murphy's questions, I will contact Mr. Abell, and in cooperation with our own counsel visit with him so that we outline as directly as possible the responsibilities and make especially clear to the Department that we do not want a proliferation of employees, and another huge bureaucracy which only spends money, so that we can really tie it down to a narrow base. With that explanation, I move the advancement of the bill as amended.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We're moving for the advancement of the bill. Clerk record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.
