CLERK: 22 ayes, 20 nays, on adoption of the Reutzel motion, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion fails. Senator Marsh, do you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR MARSH: I move we recess until 1:30 p.m.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. We are recessed until 1:30 p.m. The Call is raised.
