SENATOR KELLY: That is correct. They have to have a seal by the department in place in order to be sold in Nebraska.

SENATOR KEYES: Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion is on the advancement of the bill as amended. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Now those of you who are keeping...I'm sorry. Go ahead.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 418A.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of the A bill to E & R for review, 418A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. This is the companion bill to the first bill, 418A. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and 418A is advanced to E & R for review. Your records should show that 342 has passed, advanced the last time we met and LB 11 has been taken off the consent file as per the rules and regulations and we are now ready for LB 175, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 175.) The bill was first read on January 10. It was referred to the Constitutional, Revision and Recreational Committee. It was advanced to General File with committee amendments. Senator Simon has an amendment to the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR SIMON: Would the Clerk read the amendment, please?

CLERK: (Read Simon amendment found on page 1090 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR SIMON: This is merely clarifying language. It corresponds to the committee amendments. I move for adoption of the amendment to the committee amendments.
