Senator Venditte voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 14 nays on the adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried and the amendments are adopted and now the motion is to advance the bill to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. You have one minute to get this vote taken care of. The motion is to advance the bill to E & R for review. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 18 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. The next bill is LB 571. The Clerk will read.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 571.) The bill was first read on February 12. It was referred to the Ag and Environment Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments by Senator Schmit's Agricultural Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Schmit, I recognize you on the committee amendments first.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the committee amendments are very minimal. Number one, removes the word "grain" so that the alcohol source can include production of products such as sugar beets and potatoes which treat with the production of western Nebraska. The other amendment is an amendment which provides that the construction may be completed within twenty-four months instead of eighteen months as was originally drafted in the bill. I move the adoption of the amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Stoney, do you wish to be recognized? Sorry. Go ahead.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. Speaker members of the Legislature, one question of Senator Schmit if he would respond, please.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Schmit.
