CLERK: 11 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are under Call. Legislators take their seats. Record your presence. Legislators, you all take your seats. Unauthorized personnel leave the floor. Record your presence. How many are excused? Six excused. Senator Warner, Senator Wesely, Senator Fowler, Senator Schmit, Senator Lamb, Senator Maresh, he is excused, Senator Kahle, Senator Merz, Senator Newell, Senator Chambers, Senator Duis, Senator Kelly, Senator Labedz, Senator Reutzel. We can take votes. The Chair is going to have to close the debate in just a moment.

CLERK: Senator Nichol voting aye; Senator Stoney voting no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to cease debate. Shall debate cease? The House is under Call. We are voting on ceasing debate on LB 571. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Lewis, the Chair is going to have to call the vote. Have you all voted?
