Senator Cullan.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Cullan, will you respond?

SENATOR CULLAN: I will try.

SENATOR NEWELL: I want to do this for the record. I have been contacted by some constituents from Omaha and I am not sure whether they are in favor of the committee amendments or opposed to the committee amendments. Can you help me remember?

SENATOR CULLAN: Dave, green is the color that you want to vote on this bill.

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, yes, yes, but can you say that sort of...which groups have come?

SENATOR CULLAN: I believe, and I may be corrected and if I am I will inform you, but I believe that the groups in Omaha are in favor of these committee amendments...

SENATOR NEWELL: With the committee amendments.

SENATOR CULLAN: ...because they do...some of the committee amendments are necessary to clarify the bill, conform with the Attorney General's opinion and I think that that is necessary so that the bill can....I was just informed by Steph that the Council of the Midlands is in favor of these amendments.

SENATOR NEWELL: I just wanted to make sure that if I vote wrong I can come back and say Cullan mislead me. That is all I want to do.

SENATOR CULLAN: Believe me, if you vote wrong I will let you know.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of the committee amendments to 298. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the committee amendments are adopted. Senator Cullan, are you ready for the bill itself?
