SENATOR SIMON: Could we get Senator Schmit. He was just here a moment ago.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Schmit has been excused. The Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote found on pages 1118-1119 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: I'm sorry. We will stop the count unless you get back to your seats. We had problems this morning. Announce the vote.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to indefinitely postpone.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion... I'm sorry. What was the vote?

CLERK: 19 ayes, 20 nays.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Senator Simon, do you have a motion to make?

SENATOR SIMON: I move we advance the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is that the bill be advanced. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? The Chair is going to call for the vote for the last time. Have you all voted? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Are we still under Call? May we check in to be sure everybody is here? Then I am going to ask for a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All legislators... Senator Simon, the Chair is not going to call for any votes until every legislator is in his or her chair. We cannot allow solicitation of votes once the vote has been taken. Now will you please record your presence as per the request? Have you all recorded your presence? Senator Brennan, will you please record your presence? I guess I had better record mine too. Senator DeCamp. Senator DeCamp. Oh, there he is. Senator Chambers, all members are either present or excused. What was the request? Roll call vote on the advancement of the bill. Right? Okay, the Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on page 1119 of the Legislative Journal.) 21 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.
