SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, we go to the next bill, 143.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 143.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Clerk has an announcement on his desk first and then we will go to the next bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lewis asks that we announce that the Bellevue delegation is inviting the Senators to be their guests at the Nebraska Club for cocktails and hors d'oeuvres from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. today.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Marsh, for what purpose do you arise? Excuse me?

SENATOR MARSH: Did you raise the Call? I did not hear it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: No. The Call is raised. Are you ready?

CLERK: Yes, sir. (Continued to read title to LB 143.) The bill was first read on January 9. It was referred to the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by Senator Newell's Miscellaneous Subjects Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, members of the body, the amendments to LB 143 are a complete rewrite of the bill. Now I could go through and explain point by point these amendments but I think it is generally known in this body that these are compromised amendments, that the industry and the introducer of this legislation have come to agreement on these compromised amendments. Now we took a great deal of time on the previous bill and for that reason I would hope that these could be adopted and that the bill could be advanced without further amendments. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are referring to the committee amendments as found in the Journal on page 522. The Clerk will read an amendment to the committee amendments.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Simon moves to amend the committee amendments and his amendment is on page 513 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR SIMON: Would the Clerk read the amendment please?

CLERK: (Read Simon amendment.)
