LB 103

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move to cease debate on the Maresh motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The previous question has been called for. Do I see five hands? All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 9 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. Debate is ceased. The Chair recognizes Senator Maresh to close on his motion.

SENATOR MARESH: Probably the committee studied this for two years but the Legislature was not aware of what effect it will have on various schools and counties. I discussed this with three counties in my area and they weren't even aware that there was a bill to do this and I think we should give them an opportunity to have a response on this changing taxation so I move this be adopted, this motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are voting on the Maresh motion. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. No, this is on the motion. We have already ceased debate. Senator Maresh wants to hold the bill over until 1980. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? The Chair is going to call for the vote once more. Have you all voted? Okay, record the vote. A Call of the House has been called for. Clear the Board. All those in favor of a Call of the House vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 4 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take their seats. Record your presence. The House is under Call. Please take your seats. Senator Murphy, will you record your presence? The only two excused are Senator Beutler and Senator Hoagland. Senator Haberman, please record your presence. The motion is the Maresh motion on LB 103 which is to bracket it until 1980. A roll call has been requested. Who do we miss? Senator Schmit and Senator Reutzel. Sergeant at Arms, will you see if you can locate Senator Schmit and Senator Reutzel? Those are the only two unaccounted for. Senator Maresh, do you want to proceed with the roll call? Senator Maresh, are we ready for the roll call? Do you want to proceed? Okay, as soon as the legislators are in their seats, we will proceed with the roll call. The Clerk will read the motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, the motion is to hold LB 103 until the
