SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take their seats. Record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Record your...

SENATOR HABERMAN: Roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Murphy. Is Senator Murphy here? There are four absent. Senator Murphy. The absent ones are Senator Beutler, Hoagland, Reutzel and Frank Lewis. Senator Goodrich. Senator Goodrich. Senator Cal Carsten. Okay, Mr. Sergeant at Arms, Senator Cal Carsten. Check on Senator Chambers, Senator Goodrich. Those are the three. Senator Goodrich, we're under Call. Senator Haberman, shall we proceed with the Roll Call now? Okay, the Clerk will call the roll. We're voting on the Haberman amendment to LB 103. The Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, which may be found on Page 1141 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me. Senator Newell. Senator Newell. Hold the count. Senator Newell. Okay, proceed.

CLERK: (Continued roll call vote.) 24 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion has lost. Senator Cullan, you want to raise the Call? The Call is raised. Senator Cullan what do we do with the bill?

SENATOR CULLAN: I move that the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance 103 to E & R for Review. Senator Newell, do you wish to be...your light was on, Senator Newell. Do you wish to be recognized? Senator Schmit, do you wish to be recognized? The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I do this with great reluctance, I do not often, if hardly ever, offer to kill a bill, but I do offer such a motion at this time.
