I think we ought to do, Senator Murphy, is amend it that way and check with the billdrafters and the others if we can make that kind of an exchange and we can do that before Select File. The amendment is fine. I think you are right.

SENATOR MURPHY: I would have no objection to that but as long as we are dealing with what I think are incongruous printings the section dealing with the counties contribution I don't think is saying what we meant to say. If you are saying the county is to contribute a matching percentage or not less than a percentage of an employee's salary to this fund, then if you read that line carefully you will find instead of contributing 4%, a matching 4% for the employee, we are contributing 4% of the employee's contribution which gets it down to some kind of a decimal.

SENATOR LEWIS: Is that in the committee amendments or is that in the bill itself? Now we have amendments on the committee amendmets. I don't know if you have read that. I think Senator Cullan did a clarifying number. Let's do this since we are about out of the fifteen minutes, if I may, Mr. President. I think it is perfectly acceptable to accept your motion on the transfer of that information from that section. Let's reread that 4½% thing and if you are absolutely correct, Senator Murphy, then we will amend that on Select File, if that is all right so we can expedite the matter.

SENATOR MURPHY: Fine.

PRESIDENT: The motion then is the adoption of the Murphy amendment that is before you. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Murphy's amendment.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The Murphy amendment is adopted. The Chair recognizes Senator Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, I move the bill be advanced to E & R initial.

PRESIDENT: Motion to advance LB 416 to E & R initial. Any discussion? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? We are voting on the advancement of LB 416 to E & R initial.
