SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, I hate to prolong this and ask for a call for one more vote but since we got this far
.....

PRESIDENT: Record the vote.

SENATOR LEWIS: Nice talking to you.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. LB 416 is advanced to E & R initial. Next bill is LB 251.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 251.) The bill was first read on January 11. It was referred to the Urban Affairs Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by Senator George's Urban Affairs Committee.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator George.

SENATOR GEORGE: Thank you, Mr. President. I move the adoption of the committee amendment. The committee amendment is rather a simple one. It inadvertently, we kept the name of statutes which says downtown improvement district. Since this law obviously could be applied by such sections, if you want to take Omaha as an example, as South Omaha or Benson, downtown certainly would not be the proper name. We have changed that to business improvement and those are the only amendments.

PRESIDENT: Anything further? Any further discussion on the committee amendment on LB 251? If not, Senator George, I guess that will constitute your closing on the committee amendment.

SENATOR GEORGE: Yes.

PRESIDENT: The motion then is the adoption of the committee amendments on LB 251. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The committee amendment is adopted to LB 251. Senator George, what do you wish to do with the bill?
