adopted. Motion on the desk, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Newell moves to amend and that amendment may be found on page 1145 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President and members of the body, this amendment basically clarifies who is responsible in areas where there are misleading advertisements and so forth in the paper. I move the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? I guess that will constitute your close, Senator Newell. The motion is to adopt the Newell amendment to LB 438. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? We are voting on the Newell amendment to LB 438. One more time, have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Newell amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The Newell amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, members of the body, this bill was brought to me and the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee by the City of Omaha. Basically it is to deal with the Supreme Court decision that said the Human Relations Department of the City of Omaha had no authority because it had not been given specific statutory authority by the State of Nebraska. This bill will give it specific statutory authority by the State of Nebraska and it will be able to continue to function. I move the advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Murphy and then Senator Chambers after that.
