PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Murphy, speaking to the committee amendments.

SENATOR MURPHY: Senator Maresh, a question if you will.

SENATOR MARESH: Yes, Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: What is for good cause shown? What discussion before a committee...?

SENATOR MARESH: Oh, if a person was in the hospital or for a cause like that.

SENATOR MURPHY: The court I assume then would have the right to decide whether or not it was good cause.

SENATOR MARESH: Right, yes, right.

SENATOR MURPHY: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion on the committee amendment on LB 328? If not, Senator Maresh, I presume that will be your closing. The motion then is the adoption of the committee amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? We are voting on the committee amendments on LB 328. Have you all voted? Well, Senator Maresh, I hate to do it but it looks like it is about time to... We have avoided a Call of the House all day but if you want it... Record the vote.
