LB 101

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, members of the body, I rise in support of this bill even though it does have quite a fiscal impact. I would like to ask Senator Labedz a question.

PRESIDENT: Senator Labedz, would you respond?

SENATOR LABEDZ: Yes, Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: I see we have an A bill that calls for \$210,000. Would that be the support for this coming fiscal year?

SENATOR LABEDZ. Yes.

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay. Then what do you anticipate it will take, say the second year and the third year? Will most of that come from federal funds?

SENATOR LABEDZ: Well we are hoping so. Like I mentioned the places or the organizations through the federal government that we can apply for grants but most of those have said they will not give money to start new programs but will grant...

PRESIDENT: The Chair is going to suggest if you don't mind that if you are going to take up 101A that you wait until we get on 101A because you only have one minute left on this bill and you are never going to get to 101A if you don't get a vote.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay, thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Keyes, did you wish to speak? All right you pass so, Senator Labedz, you may close.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Since there is only one minute left I move for the advancement of LB 101.

PRESIDENT: All right, motion to advance LB 101 to E & R initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries and LB 101 is advanced to E & R initial. Now 101A.
