LB 101A, 271

SENATOR LABEDZ: Mr. Speaker, I know we haven't done this yet this morning. How many are excused? Four?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to have a Call of the House?

SENATOR LABEDZ: I would like to have a Call of the House.

SPEAKER MARVEL: A Call of the House has been requested. All those in favor of placing the house under Call vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried. The Legislature is under Call. We take call in votes as soon as the legislators are in their seats. Record your presence. Unauthorized personnel leave the floor. Okay, the Clerk is authorized to take call in votes.

CLERK: Senator Warner voting aye; Senator Chambers voting aye; Senator Koch voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The Call is raised. The next bill is LB 271. If you have a sheet, 184 has been taken off the consent file with three signatures. We are now on LB 271. The Clerk will read the title.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 271.) The bill was read January 15. It was referred to the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments by Senator Keyes' Government Committee, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are talking about LB 271, Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Read the title to that bill again while I look for it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to read the title again, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: (Reread title to LB 271.) You have committee amendments pending, Senator.
