CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. 421, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 421.) The bill was read on January 19. It was referred to the Government Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by Senator Keyes' Government Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes, we are looking for discussion on committee amendments on 421.

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. Speaker, the committee amendments simply increase the wages, the hourly pay, of the... from \$2.30 an hour up to \$3.30 an hour. It increases the pay of the judges from \$3.00 an hour to \$3.90 an hour and the other one, it brings them up to, I believe, it is to \$3.00 an hour, to \$2.90 an hour and it lets the election commissioner appoint somebody on the receiving board if there is a vacancy. I move for the adoption of the committee amendments to the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to 421. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the committee amendments to LB 421.
