SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Landis amendments to LB 396. All those in favor vote aye. Senator Goodrich, I am sorry.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Just a question of Senator Landis. Senator Landis, this is what you and I talked about and we agreed to about ten days ago, something like that?

SENATOR LANDIS: Yes, sir. This is where LB 490 is put into LB 396, one bill to cover both Lincoln and Omaha and this is the one apparently that Sheriff Roth has no objections to.

SENATOR GOODRICH: And the provisions so that we are not disturbing the Lincoln's or Lancaster County's civil service provision?

SENATOR LANDIS: No, that is right.

SENATOR GOODRICH: And we are not disturbing the Omaha position or Douglas County position? This is what we agreed to about ten days ago and I thoroughly researched it the other day and I would like to wholeheartedly support Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is on the Landis amendments to LB 396. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Landis' amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion has carried. The Landis amendments are adopted. Now, Senator Landis, what do we do with the bill?

SENATOR LANDIS: I would move that the bill as amended be advanced to E & R Initial, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting on advancing the bill to E & R for review. Motion is to advance the bill. Record.
