SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Just for the record, I tried to check with anybody that might have an interest and I found that there was no objection from, for example, the Nebraska Bankers Association, from representatives of various groups, and it is my understanding the Banking Department is accepting this amendment or whatever.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the return of LB 220 to Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is returned to Select File. Senator Keyes, do you want to move the adoption of your amendment? The motion is the adoption of the Keyes amendment to LB 220. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Senator Koch, did you want to speak? Senator Duis, do you want to speak?

SENATOR DUIS: I just wanted to ask Senator...what is your name?

SENATOR KEYES: Duis Keyes.

SENATOR DUIS: I don't need to, Mr. President. I am going over and visit with him instead of asking him on the floor.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. The motion is the adoption of the Keyes amendment to LB 220. Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Senator Wesely, 220.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, I move the readvancement of LB 220 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion is carried. The bill is readvanced
