SENATOR NICHOL PRESIDING

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Sergeant at Arms, can you find Senator Kelly? Senator DeCamp, you will go with a machine vote first, is that correct?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Let's try a machine vote to see the lay of the land and kind of go from there.

SENATOR NICHOL: We are voting on the DeCamp amendment to the Brennan amendment. It requires 25 votes. Those that favor the amendment to the amendment please vote green, opposed red. Did you still want a roll call vote, Senator DeCamp? Three are absent and three are excused, Senator DeCamp. Record, Mr. Clerk. Senator DeCamp. Just a minute.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I painfully ask for a roll call vote unless somebody wants to vote.

SENATOR NICHOL: We are all here. There are only three not voting who apparently don't wish to. A roll call vote has been asked for. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. (See pages 1171, 1172, Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 18 nays on the motion to adopt the DeCamp amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried. Now we vote on the Brennan amendment as amended by the DeCamp amendment. All those in favor of the Brennan amendment as amended by the DeCamp amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. You are voting on the amendment as amended, the Brennan amendment as amended by the DeCamp amendment. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Last call, have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.
