SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I move the previous question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The previous question has been called for. Shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. The question before the House is shall debate cease? On LB 23, shall debate cease? Have you all voted? Shall debate cease? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate is ceased. Senator Venditte, do you wish to close on your motion?

SENATOR VENDITTE: Members of the Legislature, I would just simply like to reiterate what I had said earlier about the amendments. Apparently there seemed to be some confusion as to what the amendments are going to do and, again, all the amendments say is that we want the same kind of screening process that is applied in giving a motorcycle license the same as that for a car or any other motor vehicle of this state. I know that Senator Haberman had expressed some concern that there might be some kind of fiscal note attached to this legislation and there is none. They have within their staff right now the capability of being able to promote a sound and a very efficient motorcycle license test and I suspect that since nobody is listening, is anyone listening? Raise your hand. Six people, seven. Right. That is all.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch, do you wish to talk on the amendment. Senator Beutler, do you wish to talk to the amendment. Okay, the motion is the adoption of the Venditte amendment to LB 23, I am sorry. First of all the motion is to return the bill to Select File for the specific amendment and the specific amendment is the Venditte amendment. 25 votes are necessary. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? The third time, have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 7 ayes, 10 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. The bill is not returned. What items do you have on the desk?
