LB 19, 112, 240, 375

CLERK: (Read record vote.) 37 ayes, 0 nays, 11 excused and not voting, and 2 present and not voting, Mr. President. (See Pages 1182 and 1183 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: LB 19 passes on Final Reading. Before we take up LB 112, the Chair would like to introduce from Senator Koch's district some 34 fourth grade students from Sunset Hills Westbrook District 66 in Omaha, 2 teachers and 2 parents, Gary Holm, teacher. They're up here in the south balcony. Would they wave to us? They're kind of looking over here now. Good morning and welcome to your Legislature. Now we have on Final Reading, Mr. Clerk, LB 112.

CLERK: (Read LB 112.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 112 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on Pages 1183 and 1184 of the Legislative Journal.) 33 ayes, 4 nays, 11 excused and not voting, and 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 112 with the emergency clause attached passes on Final Reading. The next bill on Final Reading is LB 240.

CLERK: (Read LB 240.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 240 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on Page 1184 of the Legislative Journal.) 37 ayes, 0 nays, 11 excused and not voting, and 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 240 passes on Final Reading. The Clerk will read on Final Reading LB 375.

CLERK: (Read LB 375.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 375 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.
