LB 102, 125

SENATOR KELLY: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Alright. Proceed then, Mr. Clerk, with Final Reading of LB 102. I might, just before you do that, Mr. Clerk, I might state for those who are in the balcony, those visiting here today...all of you students...this is what we call Final Reading. The members of the Legislature must vote on every bill and must listen to the bill being read to them, and you are listening to the Clerk of the Legislature read these bills that are passed that become law, and every word must be read, and by the rules of the Legislature, every member of the Legislature must remain at his or her desk while this is being read, and there will be over a couple hours spent this way this morning. So you're watching Final Reading. While we're doing this, I'll just announce that from Senator...introduce to you from Senator Wesely's district 41 fourth graders and 3 teachers from Meadow Lane Elementary School here in Lincoln. They're over here in the north balcony. Patricia Burling is their teacher. Would they stand up? Welcome to your Legislature, and you now can watch Final Reading as the Clerk reads on Final Reading LB 102, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 102.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 102 with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on Pages 1186 and 1187 of the Legislative Journal.) 33 ayes, 2 nays, 11 excused and not voting, and 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 102 passes on Final Reading with the emergency clause attached. The Chair would like to introduce on behalf of Senator Ron Cope, Mr. and Mrs. Dale Stubblefield from Shelton. They are constituents of Senator Cope, and they are also grandparents of Stephanie Stubblefield who is on Senator Labeledz staff. So would they please stand up and be recognized over here under the south balcony? Welcome to the Legislature to the Stubblefields. Now Mr. Clerk, will you read on Final Reading LB 125?

CLERK: (Read LB 125.)
