return, but I truly think that your constituents and mine would appreciate the fact that you continue the program as you have it. I am not saying that it should be altered. It should, but in this motion I am not saying it should be altered. Proceed with it if we must, but let's find out what we are doing with it before we start throwing more money at it. More money is not the answer. A coordinated delivery of proper services is the answer and there is no one in this room that can tell me what those services are, how proper they are, and what we have accomplished in terms of rehabilitation per se. I move that this bill be indefinitely postponed in order to create an interim study commission to intelligently look at this thing and call some of these agencies to account for an explanation of exactly what they are doing with the current million plus dollars. I move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We're voting on the motion to indefinitely postpone LB 260. It takes a majority of those voting. All those in favor of the kill motion vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 7 ayes, 21 nays on the motion to indefinitely postpone, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. We have another amendment to the bill so we will have to hold up the discussion until the first of the week. The Chair recognizes... Senator Kelly, would you like to recess us till 1:30? Excuse me, the Clerk's got a couple of motions. I'd like to...if the Legislature can come back for two hours I think we can get through and I promise you we'll adjourn at 3:30.
