LB 136, 331

Have you all voted? We are voting on the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 136. Have you all voted? LB 136, Senator Rumery's bill on cities and villages. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator George, do you want to move the advancement of the bill?

SENATOR GEORGE: Yes, Mr. President. I move the advancement of LB 136.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion then is to advance LB 136 to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement of LB 136 to E & R for review. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? We are voting advancement of the bill. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. LB 331, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 331. Title read. The bill was read on January 16. It was referred to the Government Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments by Senator Keyes' Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: This bill was brought to us by Senator Murphy and Senator Murphy came in with a full set of amendments to the bill which I will let Senator Murphy explain. I also have another amendment that was brought in by Senator Ernest Chambers and we accepted that amendment and that amendment just says that six months after a federal census the county shall, a county to redistrict itself or a subdivision of government to redistrict itself, six months after the census. It seems that sometimes they wait one year or more to redistrict so we will have them have to be redistricted within six months after the federal census. I move for the adoption of the one amendment, Senator Ernest Chambers amendment, and then Senator Murphy will take care of his amendments.
