LB 181

SENATOR GEORGE: I could, Senator Stoney, refer you to page 3 of the white committee amendments on line 13. Well, you can start on line 11. It says, "On the creation of such motor vehicle parking facility for the use of the general public, the city shall lease such facility to one or more operators to provide...", do you see the stricken language that said "may, if it desires", we cut that out and did say "shall" and that satisfied everybody interested in the bill.

SENATOR STONEY: Thank you, Senator George.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion on LB 181?

SENATOR GEORGE: I move the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion before the House is the adoption of the committee amendments on LB 181. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? We are voting on adopting the committee amendments on LB 181. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

SENATOR GEORGE: Mr. President, I now move advancement of LB 181 as amended to E & R Initial.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries and the committee amendments are adopted and Senator George moves that LB 181 be advanced to E & R Initial. Any further discussion, Senator George?

SENATOR GEORGE: Just as amended. Yes, thank you.

PRESIDENT: As amended. All right, any further discussion?

SENATOR GEORGE: No. The committee amendments are the bill. The original bill in your green section has been totally stricken.

PRESIDENT: All right, so all those in favor of advancing LB 181 vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries and LB 181 is advanced to E & R Initial.
