SPEAKER MARVEL: Now, Senator Beutler, do you want to move the bill as amended?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I would move the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of advancing LB 198 to E & R for review vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? We are voting on the advancement of the bill. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Please read the motions on the three budget bills. We have four votes that we need to take. The last time I saw it it was four.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner moves for the introduction of Request #897 by the Appropriations Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Request #897 is the appropriation that included in that bill will be that for political subdivisions and other agencies what is generally described as state aid to individuals or governmental subdivisions.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement...the introduction of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We need 30 votes on this one. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried.

CLERK: Mr. President, new bill, LB 585. Title read. (See page 1217, Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, Senator Warner moves for the introduction of Request #891.

SENATOR WARNER: All right, Mr. President, #891 is the cash funded agencies. I move its introduction.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the introduction of the bill.
