LB 59, 74, 475

CLERK: (Read LB 475 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 475 pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Senator Koch, for what purpose do you have your light on? Pardon? All right, Senator Koch. Have you all voted then on LB 475? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 1224 of the Legislative Journal.) 34 ayes, 12 nays, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 475 passes on Final Reading. The Chair recognizes Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: A point of personal privilege.

PRESIDENT: State your point.

SENATOR DUIS: I just wanted to thank Senator Kremer for naming this Holdrege after a town in my district.

PRESIDENT: He is nodding in pleasant agreement over here. Okay. We will proceed, Mr. Clerk, Final Reading, LB 59, and the Chair recognizes Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, it has been brought to my attention that there is an internal problem with 59 in terms of some redundant material. Therefore, I request unanimous consent to lay 59 over until this has been clarified by an amendment.

PRESIDENT: Mr. Speaker, there is no objection to that, it there, to just put it over? It will just be taken off of Final Reading, Senator Koch, until such is worked out. Proceed then, Mr. Clerk, with the reading on Final Reading of LB 74.

CLERK: (Read LB 74 on Final Reading.)
