LB 74, 154, 174, 176

PRESIDENT: LB 74 passes on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading, LB 154.

CLERK: (Read LB 154 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 154 pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay.

PRESIDENT: There has been a malfunction in the machine. Would you all please reregister your vote on LB 154? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 1226 of the Legislative Journal.) 37 ayes, 0 nays, 9 excused and not voting and three present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 154 passes on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading, LB 174.

CLERK: (Read LB 174 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 174 pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote. We have not announced the vote on this bill and the Clerk has just brought to my attention the fact that there is an A bill which is still on General File. By your own rules this bill should not and cannot be read and since we have not announced the vote, it would probably be proper and I think I will just order that the vote be not considered, that the bill be put aside until the A bill catches up with it as pursuant to our rules. Senator Cullan, I believe this is a health bill. Do you have any objection to that procedure since the A bill should have been with it? All right, so ordered then, Mr. Clerk. We will just nullify the entire vote and put it back. Mr. Speaker, you can put it back on General File when the A bill catches up then. Proceed then on Final Reading, Mr. Clerk, with the reading on Final Reading of LB 176.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.

CLERK: Senator Koch moves to return LB 176 to Select File for specific amendment, that amendment being to strike the enacting clause.
