SENATOR MARESH: Would 250 still allow this if it passes?

SENATOR KOCH: I think 250 will clarify all these issues. It talks about resident owner. It talks about owner of record and it talks about 60% or more of those individuals before an improvement district could become effective.

SENATOR MARESH: But they have to be resident owners. Correct?

SENATOR KOCH: In 250 they deal with... No. It deals with owners of record only. It strikes resident owners.

SENATOR MARESH: So it does about the same thing only...

SENATOR KOCH: That is correct.

SENATOR MARESH: So, how far is 250 down the line?

SENATOR KOCH: That is not too far behind this one, Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: So all you are doing is just to use...

SENATOR KOCH: I am saying we should deal with the same subject in 250 and not have two bills that deal because 250 deals with all cities.

SENATOR MARESH: You won't try to amend 250 to take out nonresident owners, will you?

SENATOR KOCH: I wouldn't promise you that, Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: That is what I am afraid. I think your reason for trying to kill this bill so you could do away with the nonresident owners. Is that correct?

SENATOR KOCH: That is one of my big concerns. That is correct.

SENATOR MARESH: I think we need to get all the cities in the same... We need to have the cities to be uniform and by passing this bill I think we are going to have uniformity, so I would oppose the kill motion.
