become paved. Now it seems to me that the wise thing for us to do is to kill this bill and then take 250 which really does deal with the very same subject and we can use 250. We can make certain that the front footage requirement is contained therein as it presently is and we could make certain that the resident owner gets that special vote rather than the nonresident owner and then we can go ahead and deal with the railroad property. But I would support Senator Koch's motion to return for a striking of the enactment clause.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Simon.

SENATOR SIMON: Mr. President, members of the body, I initially and, Senator Maresh, I guess I would like to address my remarks to you on this. It is just a comment. I, philosophically would favor Senator Koch's motion but what I might suggest that we do this morning is to bring the bill back and then ask Senator Koch not to pursue his kill motion, lay the bill over on Select File and let 250 catch up with it and then you at least have those two options. Now if you would agree with that and if Senator Koch would agree with that I think perhaps we can reach some sort of a compromise. Otherwise I will be compelled to support the kill motion.

SENATOR MARESH: Senator Simon, I would gladly do that but I think it would be better to just bracket it now if the Speaker would allow us to... A question of the Speaker. Senator Marvel.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel, a question of the Speaker.

SENATOR MARESH: With the Speaker's permission could we just leave this bill set on Final Reading and not take it up?

SPEAKER MARVEL: If you want to pass over it it is fine but I violently object to bracketing bills. That is the reason I fought you a couple of days ago. We are at a crucial time in this session. If we start bracketing bills we are going to get so fouled up that a lot of the bills that you have simply are not going to pass so we have to be very careful, in my opinion, in trying to bracket bills. If you want to pass over 176 for a day or two that is fine but please don't bracket bills. You will clog up that blackboard and we will never unravel and you will undo everything we have tried to do this session.
