SENATOR MURPHY: My apologies. I withdraw the motion. The subsequent wording in the last paragraph after the effective completion of the dam apparently infers that the prior notice shall be in writing, so I believe it is adequately covered and I withdraw the motion.

PRESIDENT: The motion is withdrawn and we are then ready, Mr. Clerk. You will read on Final Reading, LB 544.

CLERK: (Read LB 544 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 544 pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1232 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 0 nays, 9 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 544 passes on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading, LB 548.

CLERK: (Read LB 548 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 548 pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1233 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 0 nays, 9 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 548 passes on Final Reading with the emergency clause attached. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading, LB 567.
