Call. All legislators please take their seats. Record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Good afternoon, Senator Merz. We're glad to see you back. Senator Koch, would you record your presence please? Senator George...is Senator George here? Senator George, would you please record your presence? Senator... excuse me? Okay, the Chair...as long as the legislators are in their seats, the Chair then will authorize call in votes if you so desire. Senator Merz, would you please indicate your presence? Senator Cullan, would you indicate your presence? Senator Brennan...is Senator Brennan here? Senator Simon, would you indicate your presence, please? I'm sorry. Senator Cullan, would you indicate your presence? Everybody's in their seats. We'll go ahead and accept call-in votes. Senator DeCamp, I think everyone is here.

CLERK: Senator Wesely voting no. Senator Lamb voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I'm ready to announce the vote.

CLERK: Senator...

SPEAKER MARVEL: The only other thing...do you want a Roll Call vote?

CLERK: Senator Sieck changing from no to yes.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Okay, announce it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Clerk, announce the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 17 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment's adopted. The next amendment. Clear the Board. The Call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Newell moves to amend and that amendment is on Page 1174 of the Journal.

SENATOR NEWELL: Those amendments no longer apply to what is the bill now.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to withdraw the amendments?

SENATOR NEWELL: Please.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Unanimous consent has been asked to withdraw the amendments. Any objection? So ordered.
