SENATOR FOWLER: How many are excused?

SPEAKER MARVEL: 5 excused.

SENATOR FOWLER: 5 excused. Well then I'd ask for a Call of the House.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question is, shall the House go under Call? Would you please...shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 10 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators will be in their seats. Record your presence. Unauthorized personnel leave the floor. Senator Koch, would you record your presence. Senator George, Senator Warner, Senator Schmit, Senator Johnson, Senator Merz, Senator DeCamp, Senator Fitzgerald, Senator Goodrich, Senator Simon, Senator Hoagland, Senator Chambers, Senator Duis, Senator Nichol, Senator Pirsch, Senator Kelly. Mr. Sergeant at Arms, may I read to you once again the list of those who are not here, who are not recording. Senator Schmit, Senator Goodrich, Senator Simon, Senator Duis, Senator Nichol. If the legislators will please take their seats, we can accept call-ins while we're waiting for the others to...

SENATOR FOWLER: Mr. President, I'll just ask for a Roll Call so we can...

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. Roll Call has been requested. Clerk will read the amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President...

SPEAKER MARVEL: I knew we'd had a stormy day...I didn't realize it was quite that much.

CLERK: (Read the Fowler amendment to the Murphy amendment.) Senator Beutler voting aye. Senator Brennan, not voting. Senator Burrows, not voting. Senator Carsten voting no. (Roll call vote may be found on Pages 1248 and 1249 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President.
