SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. Whose bill...Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I move to advance LB 116 to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. I would appreciate it if the Legislature would stay under Call while we accept one Request from the Appropriations Committee on the introduction of a bill. The Clerk will read.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner moves to introduce Request #903 by the Appropriations Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You've heard the motion. All those in favor of the Request vote aye, opposed vote no. 30 votes we need. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to introduce, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried.
