Mr. President, Senator Koch offers substitute motions on reconsidering the action of the body in failing to adopt LB 57, and in failing to adopt LB 425.

Mr. President, Senator Burrows asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 465.

Mr. President, new bill, 344A, introduced by Senator Stoney. (Read by title for the first time LB 344A).

Senator Cullan asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 103.

Your Committee on Education whose Chairman is Senator Koch to whom we referred LB 357 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with amendments, 442 to General File with amendments. Signed, Senator Koch, Chairman.

Mr. President, Senator Koch offers explanation of vote. Senator Koch asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 59, Senator George to 181 and Senator DeCamp to LB 382, and Senator Sieck and Senator Hoagland to LB 484.

Mr. President, Senator Murphy moves to place LB 221 on General File pursuant to Rule 3, Section 10, and that will properly be laid over.

Mr. President, Senator Johnson moves to return LB 164 to E & R for the purposes of correcting an engrossing error.

SPEAKER MARVEL: What are the votes on that?

CLERK: 25.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We have to read you the bingo bill 164. This request, which needs 25 votes, returns it, Senator Johnson, to E & R for Engrossment? Okay. If you want to approve that before we adjourn vote aye. The motion is to bring 164 back for evidently some E & R amendments that have clogged up the machinery. Have you all voted? Have you all voted?
