PRESIDENT LUEDTKE PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Prayer by Chaplain Palmer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer offered.

PRESIDENT: Roll call. Record the roll call.

CLERK: A quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Any corrections to the Journal, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Notices, reports, announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a communication from the Governor. Read. (See page 1264, Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, Senator Dworak offers explanation of vote and Senator Keyes asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 285 in the Journal.

PRESIDENT: All right, we are ready then to proceed with the Special Order, 45 minutes on the agenda, LB 15 and Senator Nichol is ready. So, Mr. Clerk, if you will read.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 15. Title read. The bill was first read on January 4 of this year. It was referred to the Nebraska Retirement Systems Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by Senator Hasebroock's Retirement Systems Committee.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Hasebroock.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Mr. Chairman, Mr. President, and members of the Legislature, on page 2, line 1, after colleges, insert technical community college and University of Nebraska, and then in line 3 beginning with "Any" strike through 9. Insert a new section as follows. Now the amendments, that is primarily what the amendments will do. I think the amendments has quite a little bit to do with the bill and I would suggest that they be explained by Senator Nichol who is the introducer of the bill.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature.

PRESIDENT: Senator Nichol, go ahead.
