PRESIDENT: All right. The Chair recognizes Senator Frank Lewis. The Chair recognizes Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President, members, I will certainly support the amendment on this and then oppose the bill later. I don't think the bill is needed as I don't have anyone in my district that has ever asked me for the bill. That is where we are growing the beans out there. They don't want it. They have had a vote on it by all the people they have asked to come back in on it. They are losing money on beans now and they don't want to put another 6¢ on checkoff. So I will support the amendment but I will oppose the bill.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Nichol, I am not sure I understand something you said. You said that some general fund money will be given to this commission, then the commission will give the money back to the state?

SENATOR NICHOL: That is correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Is it like a loan then by the state?

SENATOR NICHOL: That is exactly what it is.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And how...what is the machinery or the mechanics by which this would be done?

SENATOR NICHOL: This will be taken up in the bill itself, Senator Chambers, but if you would like...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then I will wait.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Burrows.

SENATOR BURROWS: I will pass and speak on the bill.

PRESIDENT: Then, Senator Nichol, we are ready to close on the amendments.

SENATOR NICHOL: I move for the adoption of the committee amendments as amended.

PRESIDENT: The motion before the House is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 14 as amended. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments as amended, Mr. President.
