LB 560

SENATOR WESELY: Yes. I move the E & R amendments to LB 560.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner now moves to amend LB 560. Read Warner amendment offered on page 1273 and 1274, Legislative Journal.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the amendment. This is language that was language in the State Office of Programming and Planning. They under the old law had this responsibility. It is stricken in LB 412 as introduced as well as the amended copy that came from the committee and what the amendment does is place the responsibility for the coordination of collection of data and consolidate the data files or data banks and review and approve them with data processing along with all the other direction that that agency has now and the purpose, of course, is to provide common formats for the collection of data between various agencies or at least interchangeable format so that a technician can go from one agency to another without having to redesign everything or relearn the designs as they go from agency to agency. I might mention one of the overall problems that we have addressed several times in the Appropriations Committee and we will probably have a major interim study is where some of the computer usage is going to lead to but this here will be consistent with that overall program that we will be reviewing over the next year. It makes no substantive change.
