Dworak, Senator Haberman, Senator Simon, Senator Kelly, Senator Labeledz, Senator Clark. Are all legislators in their seats? The Clerk can receive votes.

CLERK: Senator Labeledz voting aye. Senator Newell continues to vote no. Senator Koch voting no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Hasebroock, would you record your presence, please? Senator Clark I think is the only one that's absent right now. All but one are present, Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I'd ask for a roll call vote, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, which may be found on Pages 1277 and 1278 of the Legislative Journal.)
26 ayes, 15 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried. The amendment is adopted. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Do you have other amendments? I move that LB 484 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the motion say aye. Opposed no. All those in favor of advancing the bill to E & R vote aye, opposed vote no...E & R for Engrossment. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 6 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried. The bill is advanced. Is there an amendment on the next bill, 291? Yes.

CLERK: Mr. President, before if I may, your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports that we have carefully examined...

SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me, Senator Kelly asks that the Call be raised. The Call is raised. Go ahead.

CLERK: ...reports that we have carefully examined and engrossed LB 23 and find the same correctly engrossed; 42 correctly engrossed; 183 correctly engrossed, and LR 5 correctly engrossed. Signed, Senator Wesely, Chairman.
