SENATOR KOCH: I guess I am sort of astonished. This bill hasn't had a red light the whole way through the board. I am going to ask for a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: Roll call vote?

SENATOR KOCH: I assume they are all in their seats, aren't they?

PRESIDENT: Everybody is here. This is on Final Reading so there is no need for a Call.

SENATOR KOCH: I will ask for a roll call then, Mr. Speaker.

PRESIDENT: All right. Commence the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote found on page 1296 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Changing from aye to nay for the purpose of reconsideration.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 58 fails on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 237.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 237 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 237 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote found on pages 1296-1297 of the Legislative Journal.) 32 ayes, 11 nays, 3 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 237 passes. Before we take up the next bill the Chair would like to introduce a friend and constituent of Senator Venditte. He is under the South balcony, Gabe Barajas. Would he stand and be recognized? Good morning and welcome to the Legislature. The next bill on your agenda, LB 241, there has been a request by Senator Nichol to the Speaker to have this laid over until
