LB 285. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? We are voting on the Dworak amendment to the committee amendments on LB 285. Have you all voted? Senator Dworak, there are three excused and absent.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I think we ought to get a record on this so I am going to ask for a Call of the House and a roll call vote, please.

PRESIDENT: All right. The board is cleared. The question is, shall the House go under Call. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 3 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion passes. The House is under Call. The Sergeant at Arms will see that all members are returned to the chamber, the members return to their desks, register their presence. All nonlegislative personnel leave the floor. The House is under Call. Senator Dworak, did you want to have a roll call? All right.

SENATOR DWORAK: Please, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: As soon as we get the members here and we will check before we have a roll call. Senator Newell, Senator Marvel, Senator Dworak, would you register your presence? Senator Reutzel, Senator Chambers, Senator Duis, Senator Goodrich are not here and Senator Cullan. Senator Cullan Senator Goodrich, Senator Reutzel, Senator Chambers. Senator Schmit, would you register your white light. It won't let us see that there is no green. All right. Senator Goodrich is not here yet. Senator Duis is coming and Senator Goodrich is coming. Senator Chambers now...

SENATOR DWORAK: Let's go ahead.

PRESIDENT: All right, we are ready to proceed with the roll call vote. The question is the Dworak amendment to the committee amendment to LB 285. Proceed with the roll call vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote found on page 1301 of the Legislative Journal.) 16 ayes, 27 nays, Mr. President.
