PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I move first of all that the bill be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All right, motion to advance... Senator George, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR MARVEL: Initial, I am sorry.

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion is to advance the bill. Senator Duis, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR DUIS: Aren't we going to speak to the motion?

PRESIDENT: Yes, if you want to.

SENATOR DUIS: I do have a very serious question. I think probably the explanation that was given to us on the last amendment that was defeated here probably was not sufficient for all of us to comprehend and to get it in that short a period of time. I certainly won't interfere with the advancement of it but I certainly would like to examine it more fully, what we have just done.

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion is then, to advance LB 285 to E & R initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays on the motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries, the bill is advanced. The Clerk has some matters to read in and then, Mr. Speaker, we can recess.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports that we have carefully examined LB 65 and find the same correctly engrossed; 428 correctly engrossed; 506 correctly engrossed; 506A, 564 correctly engrossed, signed, Senator Wesely.

Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports that we have carefully examined LB 237; 249; 315 and 373 and find the same correctly enrolled.

Mr. President, LR 35, 36 and 45 are ready for your signature.
